



Commercial Kangaroo Harvesting Boundaries




How to view commercial harvesting boundaries in Nature Maps


1. Click on link in Kangaroo Conservation and Management web page to go [Nature Maps](#).




2. Click on 'START using NatureMaps' to open Nature Maps.




3. To add boundaries of interest, such as Local Area Government boundaries, hundreds and commercial kangaroo harvest boundaries, click on **LAYERS** bottom left hand side of the home screen.




4. A side bar labelled '**LAYERS**' will appear as above.
5. Select the tick box for '**Administrative boundaries**'.
6. Expand list by clicking on the **+** next to '**Administrative boundaries**', and a drop down list will appear.



7. Select the tick box for **'Administrative'** and expand list by clicking on the **+** next to **'Administrative'**.
8. Then tick box for **Commercial Kangaroo Harvest Sub-Regions'**.



9. Selected layer will appear on map, as above.
10. If layer does not appear, try zooming into map by double clicking on the map.
11. To remove layer, un-tick box.



12. To add Hundreds Boundaries or Local Area Government Boundaries, select the tick box for "**Hundreds**" or "**LGA**".
13. Selected layers will appear on map, as above.
