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EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

PROCEDURE

The Coast Protection Act, 1972, provides that an approved management plan may be varied or revoked by a subsequent management plan prepared and approved in accordance with Part III of the Act.

The Board must, upon completion of the management plan, send a copy to each Council within the affected coast protection district and make it available for public inspection for a period of two months. Any person or Council may submit written representations to the Board during this period.

The Board submits the Management Plan to the Minister together with a statement describing the representations received and any amendment made to the management plan. The Minister may then submit the management plan to the Govenor who in turn may by proclamation, declare the management plan to be an approved management plan.

NEED FOR AMENDMENT

The Metropolitan Coast Protection District proclaimed on 28th June, 1973 was revoked and reconstituted on 21st June, 1984. As the approved Metropolitan Coast Protection District Management Plan relates to the District now revoked it is necessary to vary that part of the Plan referring to the District so that it describes the extent of the reconstituted District.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT

The policies contained in the approved Metropolitan Coast Protection District Management Plan remain unaltered. These policies will apply to the whole of the reconstituted Metropolitan Coast Protection District proclaimed on 21st June, 1984. This Management Plan and the approved Management Plan must be read together to obtain the complete set of Board policies for the Metropolitan Coast Protection District.

The appendix to this document contains maps that detail the extent of the Metropolitan Coast Protection District.

Delete the paragraph commencing 'The District' on page 25 under the heading 3 Metropolitan Coast Protection District from the approved Metropolitan Coast Protection District Management Plan (approved 21st October, 1982) and substitute in lieu thereof:

'The District. The Metropolitan Coast Protection District extends from Port Gawler in the north to Sellicks Beach in the south.

Within this area, the District includes all land that is -

- (a) within the mean high water mark and mean low water mark on the seashore at spring tides;
- (b) below and within three nautical miles of that mean low water mark; or
- (c) declared by regulation published in the Government Gazette on the 21st day of June, 1984, at page 1736, to constitute part of the coast for the purposes of the Coast Protection Act, 1972.
